Rationale:

- 1. It has become increasingly harder to get candidates to run with the decrease in the number of Anchor Clubs participating at the district level.
- 2. Allowing 2 candidates from one school could increase the likelihood of participation because they could potentially have a friend on the DAAC with them.
- 3. We are the ONLY Anchor District that limits the number of candidates from one club. Most of the other districts allow 2 candidates. One district allows 3 candidates.

Budgetary Implications:

This could potentially decrease the travel expenses if 2 officers travel from one club.
