
GOVERNOR - LAURIE FRASER'S MESSAGE

Saturday's speaker is from Honor H.E.R, focuses on homeless single women veterans to provide shelter and restore hope, honor, and dignity in every female veteran who seeks comfort, support, and assistance through their programs.

Sunday's speaker is State Representative Donna Givens – Baldwin County. Donna championed Alabama's Safe Haven law extends the surrender period from 72 hours of birth at hospitals to 45 days and enables fire stations to accept surrendered newborns if staffed by emergency medical personnel 24 hours per day providing even greater protections for surrendered infants. DHR was a key partner on the bill.

I am sure you will want to hear these outstanding speakers so get those registrations sent to Kay ASAP. If you missed getting a room, please check with other clubs to see if they have one that they plan to cancel and get that name changed to yours.
